

SWIFTSURE EVENTS SCHEDULE

Thursday, May 24, 2018

- Skippers check in with Race Committee at Swiftsure Centre in the Victoria Inner Harbour between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM
- Public welcome to walk the docks of Victoria's Inner Harbour

Friday, May 25, 2018

- Skippers check in at Swiftsure Centre in the Victoria Inner Harbour between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM
- From 12:00 noon to 4:00 PM, Captain Jack Sparrow will entertain dockside with Scarlett
- Public welcome to walk the docks of Victoria's Inner Harbour until 6 PM

Saturday, May 26, 2018

- At Clover Point, from 8:00 AM, Central Saanich Lions Club will be serving a Pancake Breakfast, while race boats begin leaving the Inner Harbour about 7:00 AM
- Race start sequences commence at 8:51 AM. The first race start is at 9:00 AM with four subsequent starts to follow every 10 minutes. Starting sequence may vary due to changes in weather. The planned order for race starts will be;
 - 9:00 AM - Juan de Fuca race
 - 9:10 AM - Cape Flattery race
 - 9:20 AM - Cape Flattery Multihulls race
 - 9:30 AM – Swiftsure Lightship Classic and Hein Bank races
 - 9:40 AM – Swiftsure Inshore Flying Sails race
 - 9:50 AM – Swiftsure Legends & Cruising races
- The Start Line will be located between a flag flying on Clover Point and a Royal Canadian Navy Kingston-class MCDV which will be at anchor

- After the start of the final race, the Royal Canadian Air Force 442 Squadron will conduct a Search and Rescue and safety demonstration over the water in front of Clover Point using a Cormorant SAR helicopter, in cooperation with the Canadian Coast Guard and local Royal Canadian Marine Search and Rescue volunteers
- Swiftsure hosts will broadcast live at Clover Point explaining the race start procedures and tactics
- The Swiftsure Inshore and Classic races will finish in Cadboro Bay near Oak Bay in the late afternoon

Saturday, May 26 and Sunday, May 27, 2018

- Follow the four long course race boats on the [Swiftsure Race Tracker](#).
- From 7:00 PM Saturday until the race is over on Monday morning, the public may watch from overhead at Ship Point, cheering on the tired and satisfied race crew, while inspection crew at the dock level of Ship Point complete safety inspections of finishing yachts..

Sunday, May 27 and Monday, May 28, 2018

- Best viewing of race yachts finishing is from the breakwater at Ogden Point – the Finish Line
- The time limit for completing all races is at 6:00 AM on Monday, May 28
