AMENDMENT #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS for the INSHORE COURSE

NOR 4.4 provides for the splitting of boats into classes. The current make-up of Inshore Race registrants lends itself to moving three boats registered in the Racing Division into the Cruising Division. The boats are similar to the boats in the Cruising Division, both in type and PHRF rating.

This change will better allow for a Racing Class and a Cruising Class to be assigned different courses from Appendix A of these Sailing Instructions, each of an appropriate length.

Course announcements as noted in SI 7.4 will identify unique courses for each of the 'Racing Class' and 'Cruising Class'.

The following is **REPEALED**:

7.3. There may be a separate course identified for each of the Racing Division and Cruising Division, and any Classes within those Divisions where applicable.

The following is **ADDED**:

7.3 Courses will be identified for each of the Racing Class and the Cruising Class.
